

## Candidate for the position of Vice-Chair

Mrs Marie-Christine Doffey Director Swiss National Library

Marie-Christine Doffey is Director of the Swiss National Library since 2005. She holds a degree in Antiquity studies from the University of Fribourg and a Master of Advanced Studies in Arts Management from the University of Basel. She has worked at the Swiss National Library since 1991 in different departments and was Vice Director from 2003 to March 2005.

During her career she has been active in supporting cooperative initiatives in Switzerland and abroad, especially in the field of digitisation and the preservation of cultural heritage, notably in the audiovisual field as President of Memoriav, the Association for the preservation of audiovisual heritage of Switzerland, as Vice President of the Board of Trustees of the Swiss National Sound Archives. As a member of the Steering Committee of the Conference of Swiss University Libraries she has ensured cooperation at the national level between university libraries and the Swiss National Library, for example in the field of long term archiving of electronic dissertations at the National Library. Other cooperative initiatives include long term preservation of the web with the cantonal libraries.

She has been Vice-Chair of the CDNL since 2012 and is also Vice-Chair of the Conference of European National Librarians since 2011, and a member of The European Library Management Committee.
