Taxi drivers help libraries deliver books to people who are home-bound










Inculcate the importance of environmental conservation in the young through a world-first green children's library and programmes


The First Singapore Bird Book

Despite its relatively small size and urbanized environment, Singapore has a rich avifauna which has attracted interest since the 19th century. However, it was only in 1927 that the first book on the birds of Singapore was printed – <u>The Birds of Singapore Island</u>, co-authored by John Alexander Strachey Bucknill and Frederick Nutter Chasen, and published by the Raffles Museum.




Digitize biodiversity materials in Singapore to promote awareness and research




Make parliamentary records accessible and free for all through digitization efforts
